# A Word from our 2018 President Mary Ann Guilinger


In 2018, Fortuna Tierra Club had a great fundraising year: raising \$12,519.00 in the third annual Log Hill Hustle on August 26, 2018. We want to thank all our sponsors, volunteers, and race participants. The number of racers almost doubled from 2016 and 2017 to 146 runners with 33 students and 20 teachers in 2018. In 2016 and 2017, the Log Hill Hustle had 79 and 78 racers with 4 and 3 students, respectively. In 2018, FTC changed the date of the Log Hill Hustle from the third Saturday of September to the day before school started in August, thus the greater participation by students and teachers. In 2019, Fortuna Tierra will be hosting the fourth annual Log Hill Hustle on Sunday, August 25th, and the race will be a chipped race because of the increase in racers. We hope you can join us in 2019.

### 2018 HIGHLIGHTS


- ◆ \$10,000 presented to Graduating Ridgway High School Seniors and continuing education students residing in the Ridgway School district.
- **♦** \$1,300 donated to the Ridgway Elementary School Teachers for classroom supplies.

- **♦** Record Net profit *Log Hill Hustle* Fundraiser = \$12,519.65
- ◆ Ended Fiscal Year \$4,663.16 <u>above</u> budgeted forecast






